We have worked with government and industry to improve training, worked with clients to improve working conditions and worked with employees to improve service delivery. This creates a model based entirely on human relationships.



Working the Halifax International Security Forum

Once again Northeastern has provided security personnel and management to the Halifax International Security Forum. This has been an annual event that hosts leaders from the military, government, business, academia and the media. Safety Minute - Smoke Alarms, A Sound You Can Live With!

Home fires kill eight Canadians a week. Most of these deaths could be prevented by taking a few precautions. Follow these tips from *Fire Prevention Canada* to help protect you and your family :



Every month—Test your alarm: Press the button on your smoke alarm and keep it pressed down. The alarm should sound. If your alarm has no button, it is out-dated and must be replaced.

Twice a year—Change the batteries in all smoke alarms twice a year (for example, when you change your clocks in the fall and spring).

Every two years—Take the cover off and clean it with a damp cloth. Carefully vacuum the inside of the alarm. Put the cover back and make sure the alarm is working.

Every 10 years—Replace your smoke alarm. Some models last as little as 5 years. If the smoke alarm is not working, replace the battery. Check fuses and circuit-breakers, or call an electrician. There may be an electrical problem in your home.


