Northeastern began in 1983 at the residence of Mark Joseph in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia. He quickly expanded his customer base which required a more formal operating setting, and at some point Northeastern leased a space on Kempt Road in Halifax, Nova Scotia. The Halifax location lasted several years, at which point Northeastern downsized once again to Mark's private residence for a brief period, in reaction to market conditions at the time.

In December of 2000 Mark moved the company into a leased space at 177 Main Street, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia. It wasn't long before Northeastern saw tremendous growth and expansion into various product lines. This put Mark in a position to purchase the entire building (under another one of Mark's separate companies—Joseph Properties). Mark's real estate company then expanded to include several other properties that spanned over two countries. A deal came along to sell the building at 177 Main Street, and after several years Northeastern relocated to a leased space at 202 Brownlow Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia—our current location. Mark spearheaded a major renovation of the current space which allowed him to better position Northeastern as a regional leader in security technology. The renovation was completed in November 2011, and we plan to stay here for quite a while thanks to Mark's vision and tenacity for getting the job done!
